Automatic carryover does not apply to: centers (P50, P60, P30, other), cooperative agreements (U), Kirschstein-NRSA institutional research training grants (T) and fellowship grants (F), non-Fast Track Phase I SBIR and STTR awards (R43 and R41), clinical trials (regardless of activity code), and awards to individuals.
